### **EVENTER TRIAL / SHOW JUMPING**

Starting at approx 1pm

Class 10	Eventer Trial	Mini	Jumps Max. 60cm
Class 11	Eventer Trial	Novice	Jumps Max. 85cm
Class 12	Eventer Trial	Intermediate	Jumps Max. 1m
Class 13	Eventer Trial	Open	Jumps Max. 1m 10

Each combination will jump a Show Jumping round that will be followed immediately by the Cross Country round. Scoring will be as in Riding Club Horse Trials Show Jumping and Cross Country, with the Cross Country timed. Times will be published and, in the event of a tie, the person nearest the optimum time will be the winner. In the event of a dispute, B.R.C. Rules will apply. The courses will be open for inspection from Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> at 2 pm.

**Entry Fee £18 Entries open on July 3<sup>rd</sup> and close on July 21<sup>st</sup> Late entries will be accepted with a £5 surcharge.**
